During this difficult time Weston Gardens will continue to provide the best possible care for our residents and staff. We are following all the directives from the Min. of Health and the RHRA to ensure the safety for all.

Our “Team” here at Weston Gardens has shown dedication, patience, hard work, sacrifice and commitment to our residents, to their own families and to you, to keep your loved ones safe.

Some of the measures we have taken to protect our residents, staff and their families are:

- Screening of our residents, staff and essential visitors are completed twice daily (including temperatures).
- Anyone who fails screening are not allowed into the building.
- Non-essential visitors are not permitted in the building. Only those providing critical care for our residents are allowed and are screened.
- Our staff do have a good amount of PPE (Masks, gloves, gowns hand sanitizer etc.) on hand to keep them safe.
- Parcels/supplies can be dropped off at our front door screening table from 5:30am – 9:00pm
- Residents can go out and are encouraged to go outside for some fresh air but, must remain on our terrace area. (No visitations are allowed with family)
- We have altered our dining room seating to accommodate physical distancing taking tables of 4 people to 2 people and expanding our dining room past the fireplace.
- Large entertainment and recreational activities have been canceled. Small group activities are conducted while we practice our physical distancing.
- We have limited our seating in our main lounges to stop congregating of residents.
- Housekeeping continues to disinfect all high traffic areas, multiple times during the day this includes touch surfaces like elevator buttons, door handles and hallway rails.
- We continue our ongoing training and updates to our staff as we get them.

Families are encouraged to call, write letters, make signs, and send pictures for family members. Please stay at home whenever possible as we are there for you.
