Short Term Absences Requirements

- Weston Gardens Retirement Residence must NOT be currently in a COVID-19 outbreak.

In the event that Weston Gardens allows absences but enters into an outbreak, all new absences must end. Weston Gardens must establish compliance with all CMOH Directives for homes in outbreak and follow directions from Toronto PHU.

- Family members can take a resident out to their own home, appointments, shopping etc. up to 2 times per week.
- This "Short Term Absence" MUST be booked a minimum a 48 hours ahead with Karen Myall our Director of Recreation. By phone 416-241-1113 or by email karen@westongardens.ca
- Weston Gardens has 6 hour maximum, anytime between the hours of 9 am to 4 pm. 7 days a week.
- Weston Gardens Retirement Residence must know where the visit will be happening at the time of booking for possible tracing purposes. Physical distancing should be maintained at all times during the visit to limit the possibility of catching Covid-19.
- A cloth or 3 ply mask must be worn by the residents outside the residence and should be wore by all people visiting to limit the possibility of catching Covid-19. Residents should supply their own masks. **As of Saturday, August 15th Residents must provide their own face coverings for being in public areas and for visitations.
- An outdoor visit in a backyard, park etc. is strongly encouraged and weather permitting.

*Please note all residents must pass active screening every time they re-enter Weston Gardens Retirement Residence. If a resident cannot meet the screening conditions, the residence will follow existing outbreak/ isolation policies.
